

Consultation & Communications Plan

Goals

- Inform participants about the Housing Needs Report and its role in shaping the Official Community Plan (OCP) Amendment.
- Share clear information about the change, and how it will continue to adhere to the OCP's original mission and vision.
- Build awareness and transparency around the amendment process.





Stage 1: Engagement Planning (March to April)

• Establish an engagement plan to guide public and interest-holder involvement throughout the OCP review process.

Milestones: Consultation and Communication Strategy & Council Presentation



Stage 2A: Project Introduction & Interest-Holder Outreach (May)

- Communicate the project's purpose and background information to the community and interest-holders.
- Facilitate targeted meetings with key groups to gather initial feedback and address specific interests.

Milestones: Social Pinpoint Launch, First Interest-Holder Meetings, Media advisory



Stage 2B: Public Engagement (June-July)

 Implement public engagement activities using diverse methods to maximize community participation and input.

Milestones: Open house, pop-events, online (i.e., project updates, 'a question a day')



Stage 3: Reporting and Recommendations (August-September)

- Consolidate and analyze feedback to identify key themes and insights.
- Present engagement outcomes, informing the development of final OCP recommendations.

Milestones: Engagement Summary & Presentation to Council



Stage 4: Bylaw Adoption Process (October - December)

- Preparation of the Bylaw
- Statutory Referral
- Public Hearing
- Milestones: Council readings, public hearing, bylaw adoption
