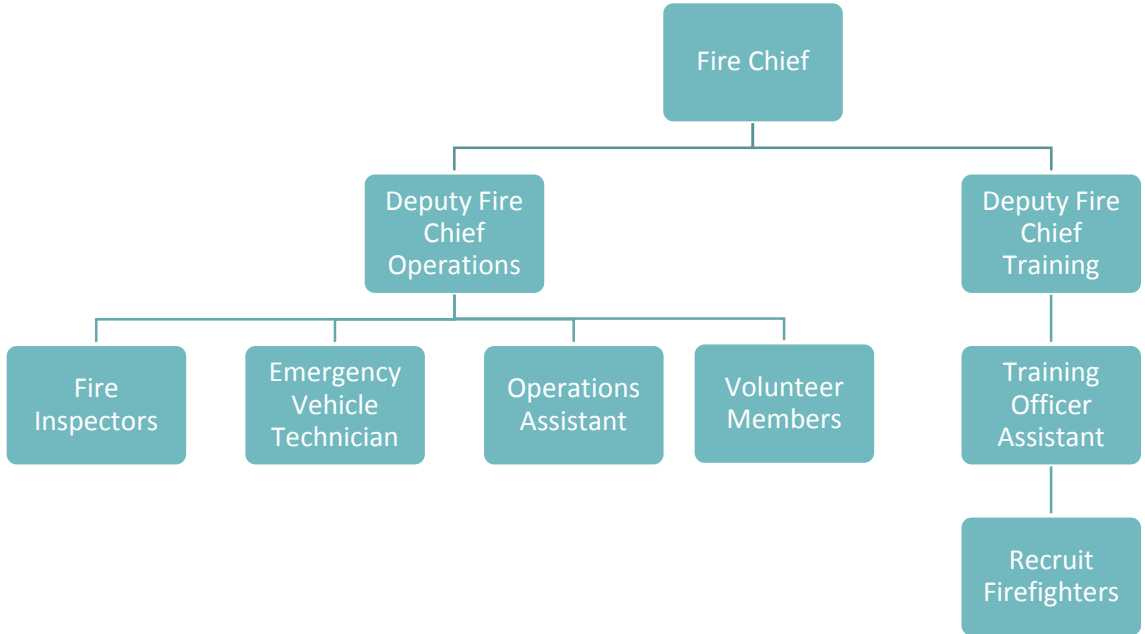

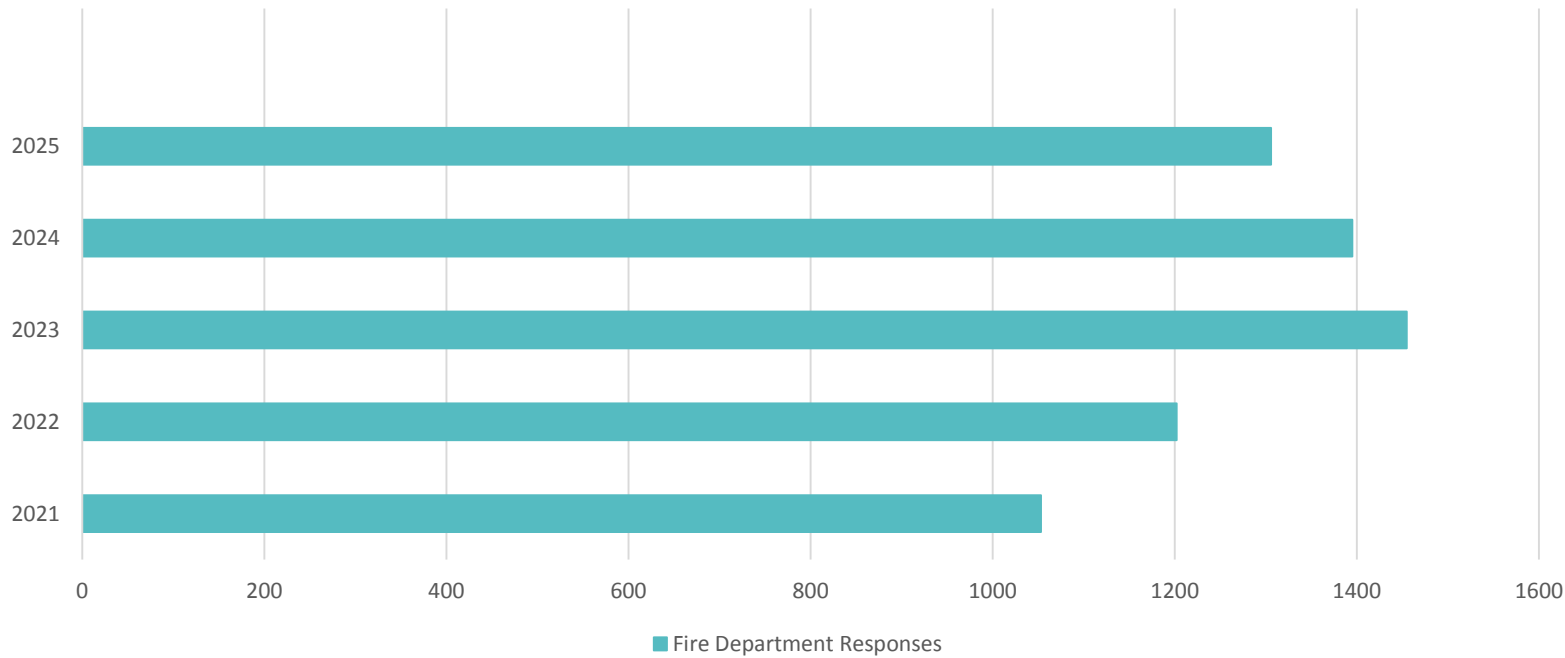

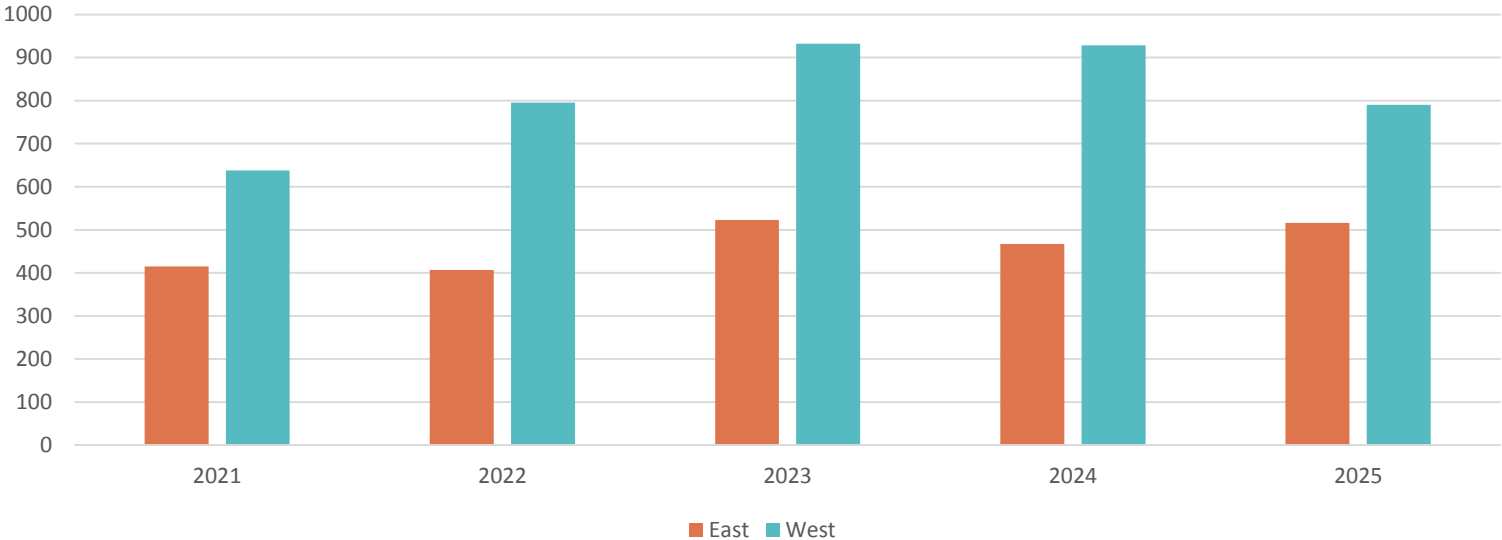
## Responses by Year 2021 - 2025

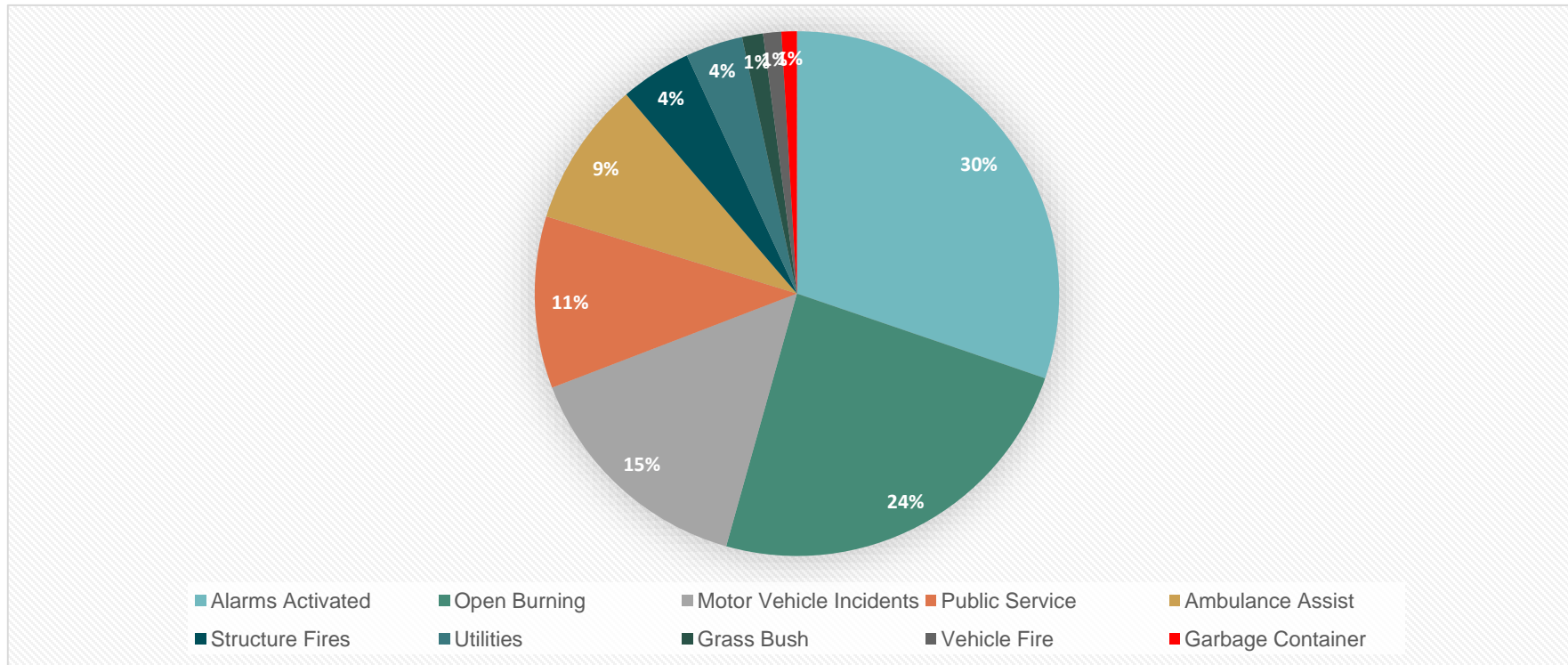
## Responses East vs. West 2021 - 2025

## Responses by Type

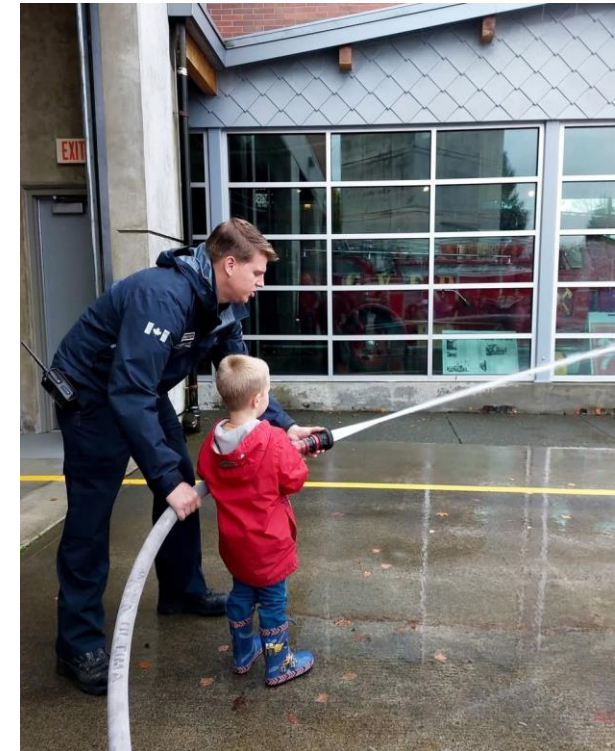

## 2025 Activities

- 1842 fire inspections
- 191 public safety events
  - 49 school age children's events
  - 50 adult fire safety sessions
  - 33 NEPP/FireSmart presentations
  - 59 smoke alarm checks
- 207 fire reports
