Top Downtown Calls for Service

- In the third quarter of the 2025-2026 fiscal year, there was a 178 file increase in the number of Calls for Service in downtown Courtenay relative to the third quarter of the previous fiscal year.
- There were notable increases in Calls for Service pertaining to Unwanted Person, Breach, and Suspicious Circumstances. The increase in Calls for Service for Breach was largely attributable to warrants issued at the Courthouse.

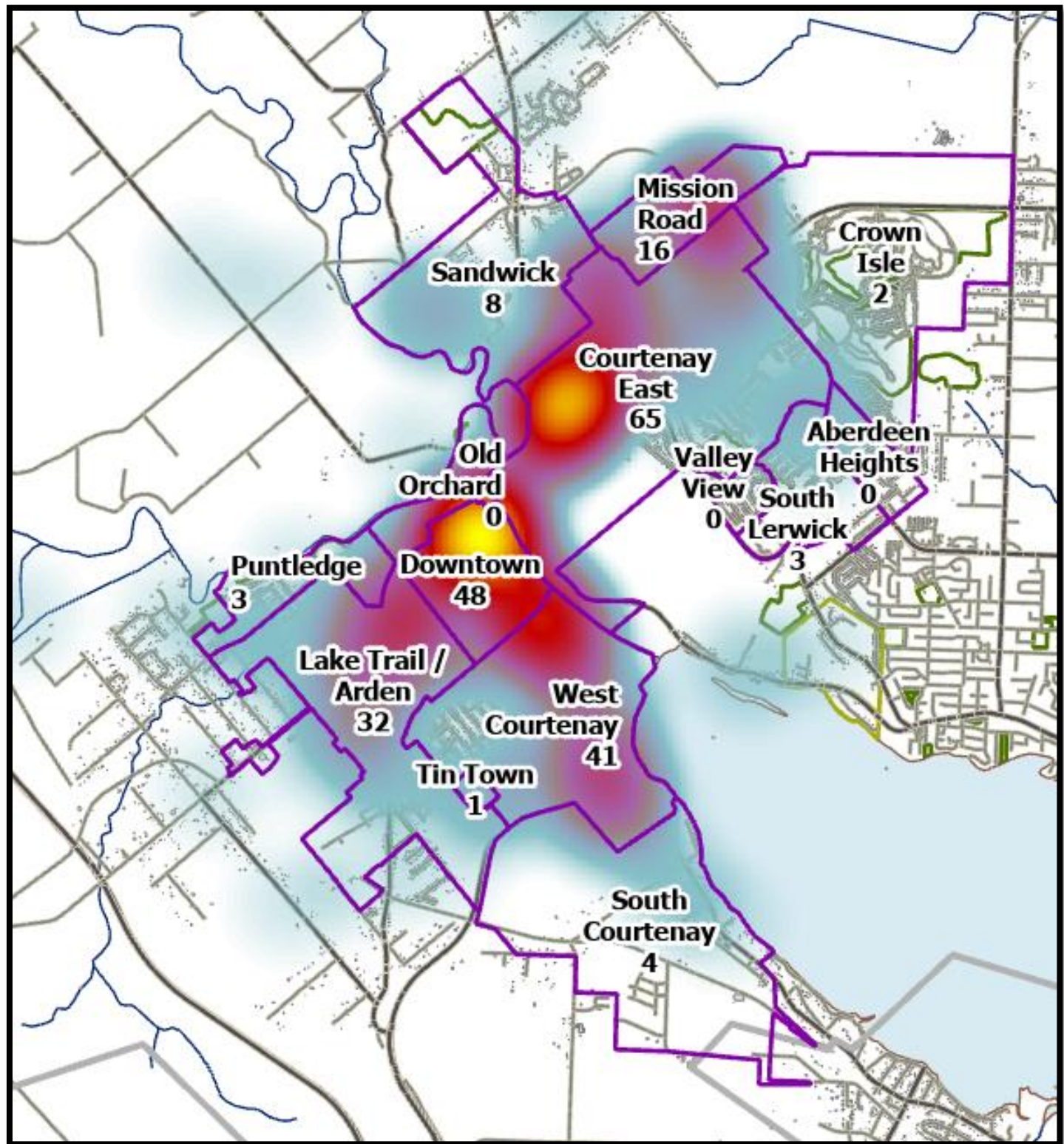

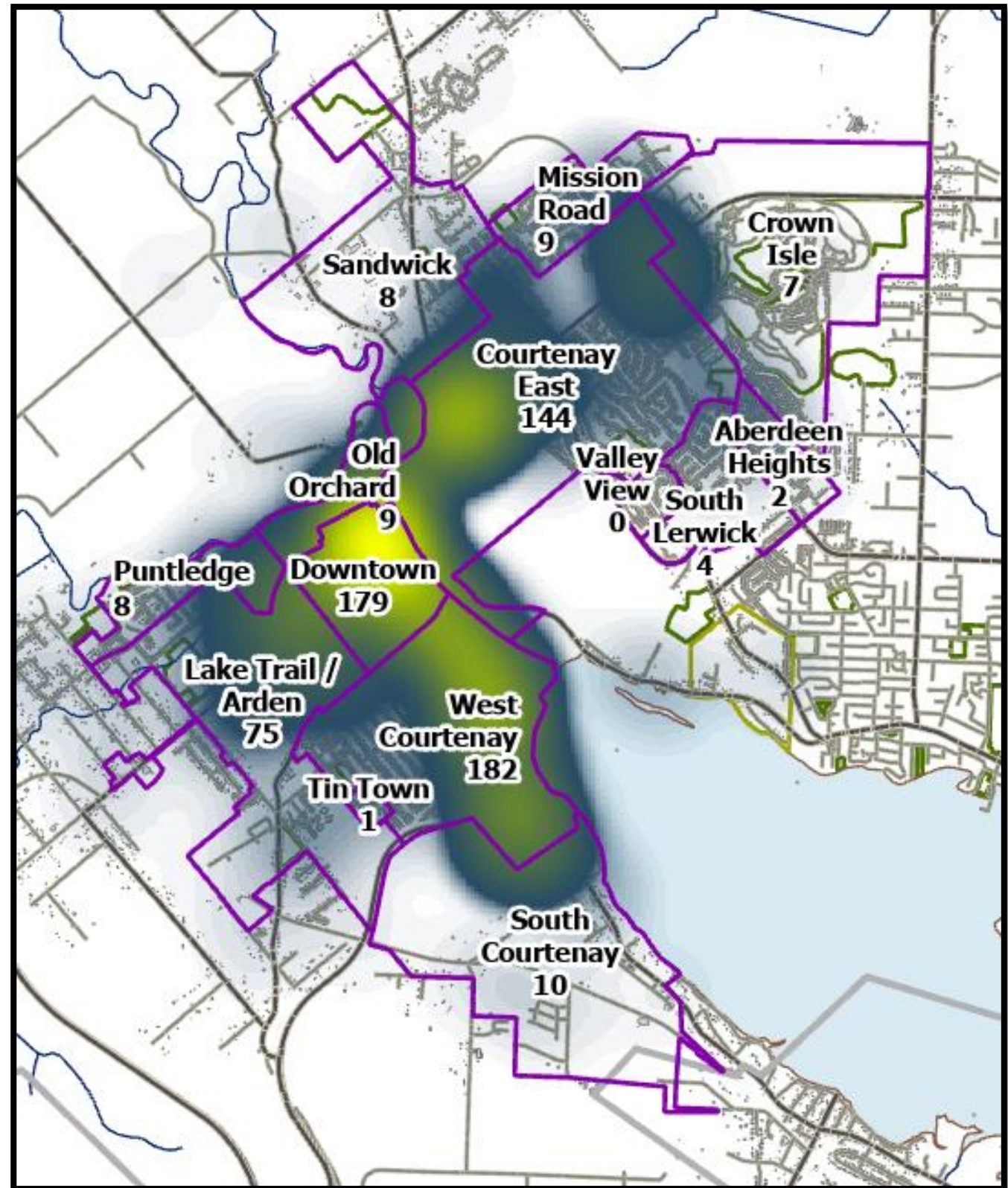
