925 Braidwood Neighbours is a grass roots neighbourhood organization formed in April 2024 after learning of BC Housing / City of Courtenay's proposed shelter(s) and supportive housing at 925 Braidwood Road.

We support the proposed supportive housing but oppose the proposed shelter(s) on the 925 Braidwood Road site for a number of reasons, from the safety of shelter(s) users due to the busy Ryan Road location, drivers/motorists, safety and well-being of residents in the proposed supportive housing, to where individuals will stay each night when the shelter reaches capacity, currently planned for 40 beds.

We are submitting a petition with signatures from the neighbourhood / East Courtenay supporting the supportive housing but opposing the shelter(s).
