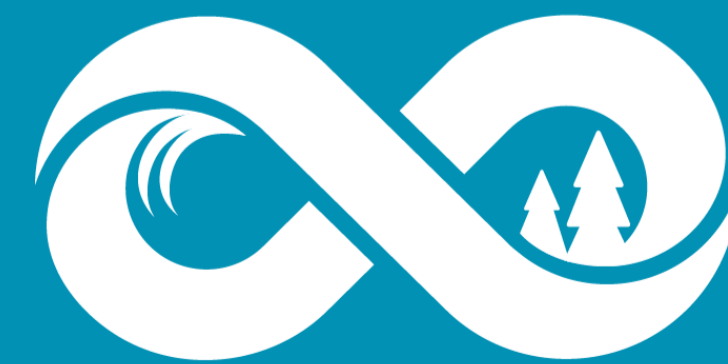

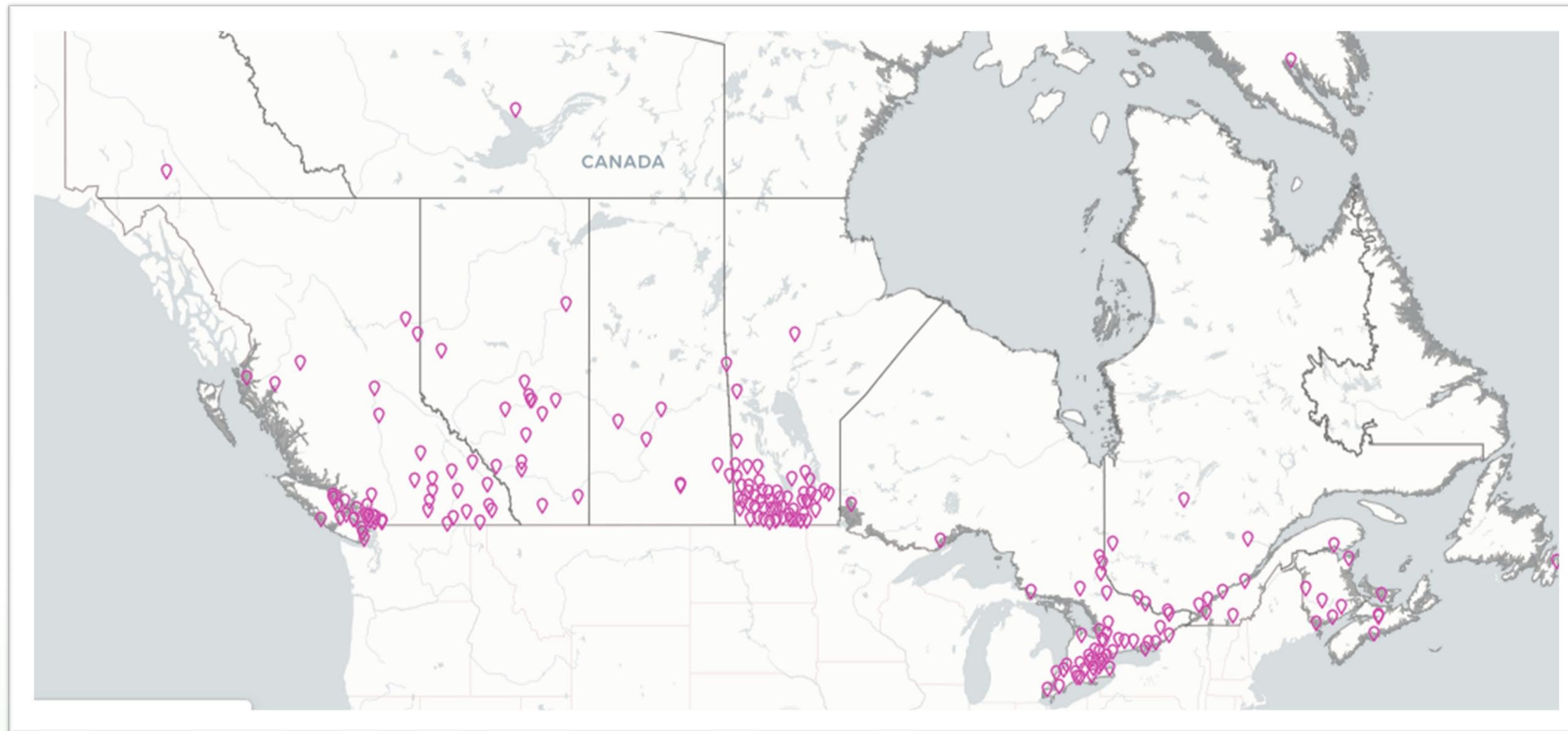

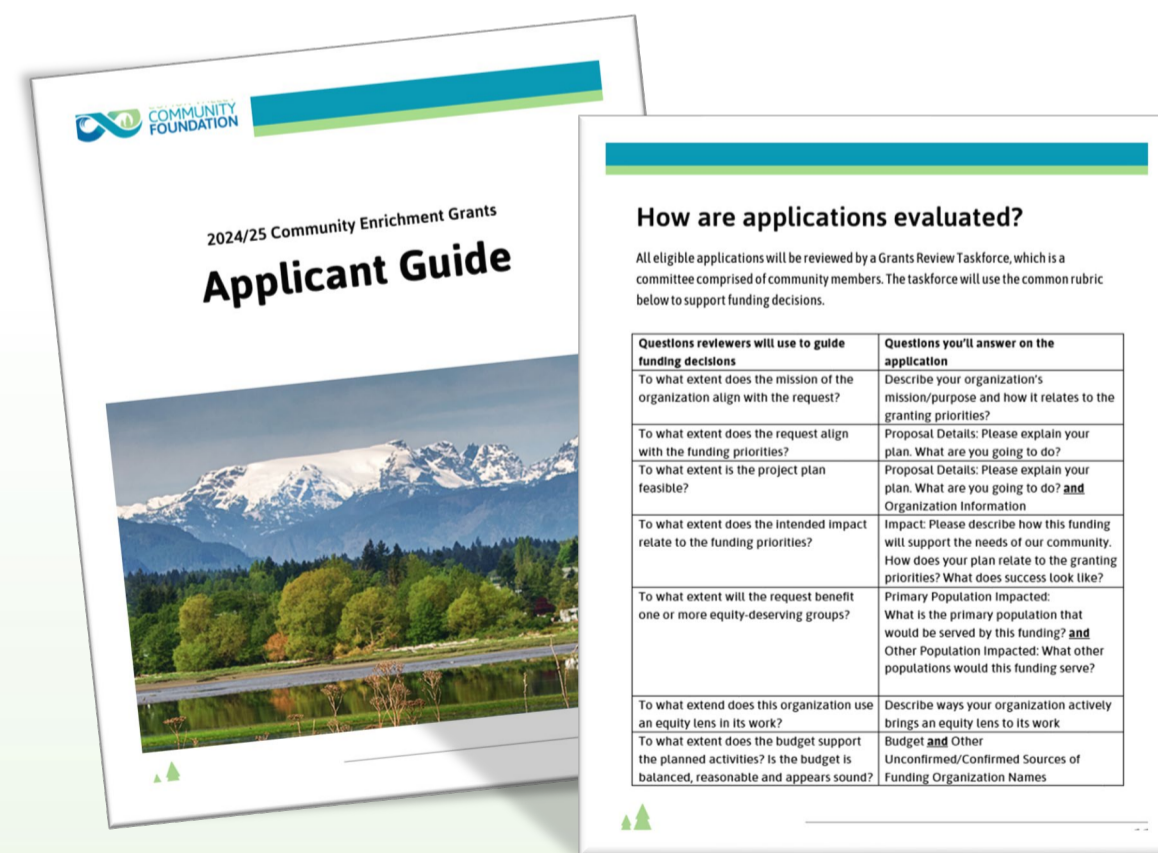

Grant Review Task Force

Attributes

- 6 to 8 Comox Valley community members
- Min 5 years non-profit experience preferred
- Representation of sectors related to funding priorities
- Diverse backgrounds, ages, and experience
- Not previously participated
- Cannot be a grant applicant or staff
- Must complete reviewer training



What is the Board's role?

- Oversight for compliance
- One-time participation as a reviewer

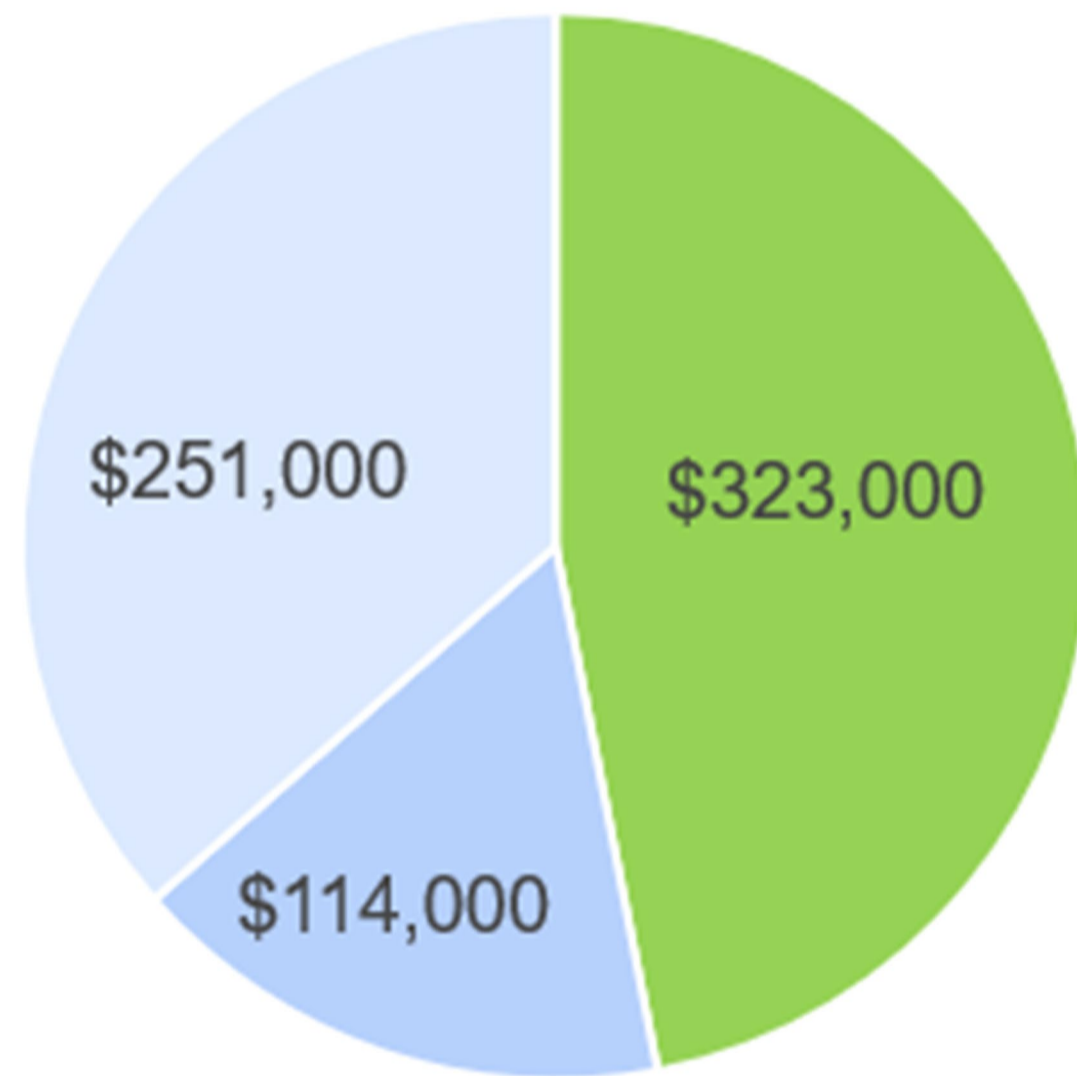




Recent funding outcomes

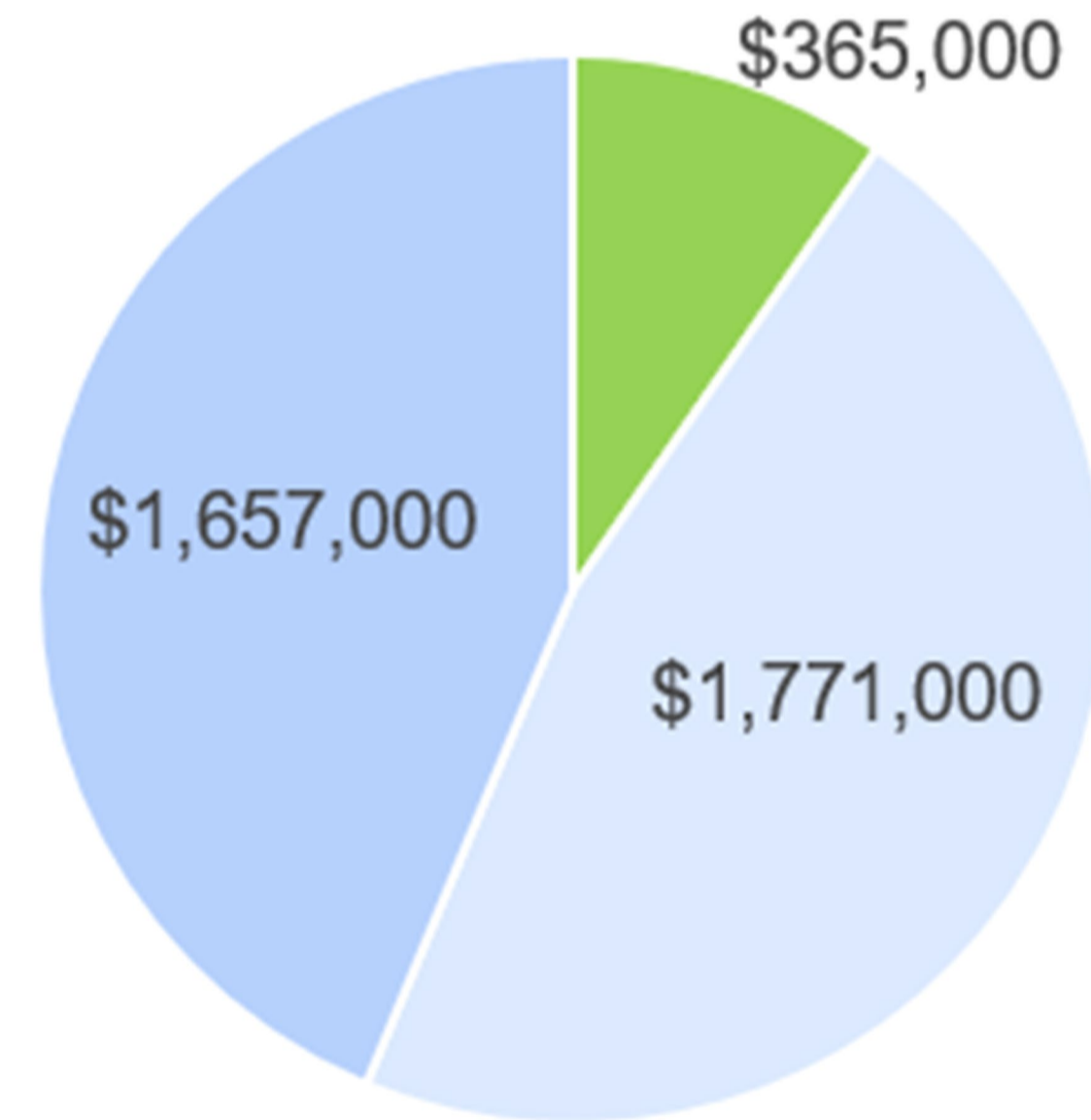
How much is the shortfall?
