# Importance of the park

• The park is a busy area, especially near the airpark, increasing the need for safe access.





### Benefits of the sidewalk

- Safety:
  - Provides a safe, designated walking area for children, residents and pedestrians.
  - Reduces risks associated with navigating through parking lots and around private properties.
- Accessibility:
  - Connects the preschool directly to the park and nearby residential areas.
  - o Encourages families to visit the park more often.

## Safety Points

#### **Traffic Concerns:**

- Crowded Roads: Expect heavy traffic around the park making it tough to get in and out.
- 2. Parking Problems: Not enough parking spaces can lead cars to spill into nearby neighborhoods.
- 3. Safety Risks: More cars on the road can increase the chances of accidents, particularly where there are a lot of pedestrians.

#### **Visibility Concerns:**

- 1. Confusing Signs: If there aren't clear signs for crossings or park entrances, it can lead to accidents.
- 2. Blind Spots: Drivers turning onto busy roads might not see oncoming cars because of park features, creating danger.
- 3. Pedestrian Awareness: Better-marked and brighter crosswalks can help keep everyone safer and more aware of each other.

#### **Environment**

- 1. Porta Potty: Sometimes it's left with doors open, which not only looks unkempt but can also be a privacy issue.
- 2. Garbage Issues: Overflowing trash cans and litter scattered around can make the park feel dirty and uninviting.
- 3. Bad Smells: Odors from porta potty and garbage can create an unpleasant atmosphere for the children and the rest of pedestrians.


